

1. One female player is recommended to be on the court at all times, but it's optional if your team can't locate any female players. Teams can have more than 1 female on the court.
2. Scoring
 - Every shot whether made by boys from inside the arc shall be awarded 2 points.
 - Every shot whether made by boys from behind the arc shall be awarded 3 points
 - Every shot whether made by girls from inside the arc shall be awarded 3 points.
 - Every shot whether made by boys from behind the arc shall be awarded 4 points
3. Playing Time/ Winner of a Game
 - The regular playing time shall be 1 period of 9 minutes.
 - The first team to score 21 points or more wins the game if it happens before the end of regular playing time.
 - If the score is tied at the end of regular playing time, an overtime shall be played. The first team to score 2 points in the overtime wins the game.
4. Fouls/Free Throws
 - A team is in a penalty situation after it has committed 6 fouls.
 - If the foul is committed on a player in the act of shooting, that player shall be awarded a free throws as follows:
 - If the shot released from the field goal area is successful, the goal shall count and, in addition, 1 free throw.
 - If the shot released from inside the arc is unsuccessful, 1 free throw. **1 free throw worth 2 points will be awarded to boys,1 free throw worth 3 points will be awarded to girls**
 - 1 free throw shall be awarded as of the 6th team foul.
 - If the shot released from behind the arc is unsuccessful, 1 free throws. **1 free throw worth 3 points will be awarded for for boys,1 free throw worth 4 points will be awarded for for girls**
5. How the Ball is played

Following each successful field goal or last free throw (except those followed by ball possession):

- A player from a non-scoring team shall resume the game by dribbling or passing the ball from inside the court directly underneath the basket (not from behind the end line) to a place on the court outside the arc.
- The defensive player is not allowed to play for the ball in the “no-charge semi-circle area” underneath the basket.
- A player is considered to be “outside the arc” when neither of his feet is inside or on the arc line.

6. Time- outs

- Each team shall be granted 1 time-out. Any player or substitute can request a time-out when the ball becomes dead prior to a check-ball or free throw.
- All time-outs shall last 1 minute.

7. Safety term

- Within the 3 second zone, male can't jump (both feet leave the ground) and block the girl's shot, if violation, then it's an automatic two points addition for the victim side.
